



Health & Safety Policy Statement

It is the policy of Total Fitout, in so far as is reasonably practicable, to seek and provide safe working conditions for all Total Fitout personnel, whether working on a full time, part time or voluntary basis and to enlist the active support of Total Fitout personnel and contractors in achieving such conditions.

Total Fitout is committed to:

- Ensuring this OH&S policy is appropriate to the purpose, size and context of the organisation and to the specific nature and scale of the organisations OH&S risks and OH&S opportunities.
- Provision of a safe and healthy working condition for the prevention of injury and ill health.
- Promoting standards of health, safety and welfare that fulfil current legal and regulatory requirements as well as codes of practice and other requirements.
- Providing and maintaining a safe working environment, safe systems of work and to protecting Total Fitout personnel, workers and the public, in so far as is reasonably practicable.
- Ensuring that all Total Fitout personnel whether full time, part time or voluntary are informed of the Organisation Health & Safety Policy through their Safety Induction to Total Fitout and ongoing Safety Training.
- Making available Total Fitout Health & Safety Policy to interested third parties.
- Providing Total Fitout personnel with the information, training and supervision that they need to carry out their activities safely and efficiently and to develop safety awareness among contractors and the public.
- Consultation and participation of workers, and, where they exist, workers representatives.
- Defining responsibilities with respect to health and safety matters.
- To eliminate hazards and reduce OH&S risks.
- Providing a framework for setting and reviewing OH&S objectives.
- Encouraging full and effective joint consultation, with Total Fitout personnel and third parties, on all health and safety matters.
- The Continual Improvement of the OH&S Management System, their Safety Statement, and to ensuring that it is reviewed annually to ensure that it remains relevant and appropriate to Total Fitout.

To ensure that the above objectives are met, Senior Management are committed to playing an active role in the implementation of the Safety Statement and undertake to review and revise it in the light of experience and developments.
